It is already time to invite you to our 2nd Roma Camp in Šutka-Skopje MK. It will take place the first 10 days of August 2018. The first Camp was a huge success – thanks to our wonderful participants, teachers, visitors, and Šutka with all its surprises. Based on our experiences we have implemented improvements regarding accommodation and daily logistics. We are excited to do it again and look forward to hosting you.

Why Šutka? Šutka isn't exactly a tourist destination, and many Macedonians would never even entertain the thought of visiting this neighborhood. Šutka, with 40,000 inhabitants, is one of the largest Romani mahalas in Europe and for sure a good choice to get in touch with Romani culture. Visiting Šutka feels like entering another country.

The architecture features very poor houses next to huge, colorful ones decorated with gaudy lion statues and wagon wheels. People speak Romani. Life is lived out on the streets, and it's lived loudly.

It is nothing like a typical Macedonian or Eastern European neighborhood. That is why Šutka doesn't have a single hotel. For the Seminar we have arranged lodging in Ferus Mustafov's motel, not too far from Šutka. It is small, but it has a nice big cool hall where we will hold music and dance classes and have dinner. We have also arranged private apartments in the heart of Šutka.

We offer dance, singing and music lessons. Instrumental lessons depend on the participants. You can choose accordion, trumpet, saxophone- / -clarinet, baritone, tuba, dumbek and tapan. Vaska and Šani will teach singing lessons. You can also book private lessons with all teachers (not included in the seminar fee)

Occasionally we will attend Roma weddings in Šutka; on these days there will be no afternoon lessons. Touristic sightseeing tours are not included but we can help you with travel information in Skopje.

Registration and Fees:

The fee for the camp is 770 €. It includes lodging for nine nights, breakfast and dinner, eight days with program, dancing, singing and instrumental lessons and airport transfers. If you choose to leave on the 6th the fee is 500,- €
